# SNUG PRIMARY SCHOOL UNIFORM POLICY



It is the expectation at Snug Primary School that all students will wear school uniform. It identifies us as part of a school community and part of a team.

Priority has been given in the establishment of the school dress code to develop a cost effective and flexible uniform, that provides all students with the opportunity to fully comply with the school's requirements. Students in uniform feel part of a team, generally have a more positive attitude, and look great! Security around the school is also significantly enhanced as our children can be readily identified. All items are available from the uniform shop at school, at no profit to the school.

The School and School Association approved uniform, is expected to be worn by all students at school, on excursions and when representing the school in any manner, such as sporting events or miscellaneous community participation.

#### **General Information**

- · One signet ring of special significance, wristwatch and, for students with pierced ears, sleepers or studs.
- · For health and hygiene reasons, students with long hair need to have their hair tied back, braided or plaited.
- · Make-up or nail polish are not to be worn to school.
- · Hair colour and buzz art patterning should be done during school holiday time, not during term time as this can distract from learning.
- · Only maroon coloured winter beanies and black scarves are allowed. These can be purchased from the school or your choice of shop, as long as the maroon colour is the predominant one. No logos or branding will be accepted on any worn item.
- · All items of uniform should be clearly marked with the pupil's name. It is best not to mark on tags as these can be easily removed.
- · Parents/guardians are asked to provide their child with a note if they are unable to wear their school uniform. It would be appreciated on these occasions if clothing could match uniform colours, e.g. maroon, yellow (gold) and black.
- · Ribbons/hair clips/bands should be in school colours.

### **School Shop**

All items are available from the uniform shop located in the Administration Block. You can purchase any uniform item on any school day between 9:30am - 2:00pm when school terms are in session.

In order to reduce the burden on parents, all uniform pieces are purchased at the most competitive wholesale rates and no profit margin added.

#### **Sunsmart Hat Policy**

In terms 1 and 4, all children must wear a hat during recess, lunchtime and outside activities. Children without a hat will be instructed to play or sit in the shaded areas to protect them from UV rays.
