

- * Feral Cats didn't originate from Australia. Cats were brought here by the Europeans. As well as cats, cows, sheep, rabbits, foxes and a lot of other animals as well. All cats have amazing eyesight and hearing. Their ears can go a whopping 180 degrees.

Cats have pads on their feet so that they can sneak up on their prey. In their pads they have tiny holes in those holes they have hairs. Cats carry a very bad disease called Toxoplasmosis. Toxoplasmosis can make native animals blind or deaf. Then they won't be able to eat or find shelter so they will die.
