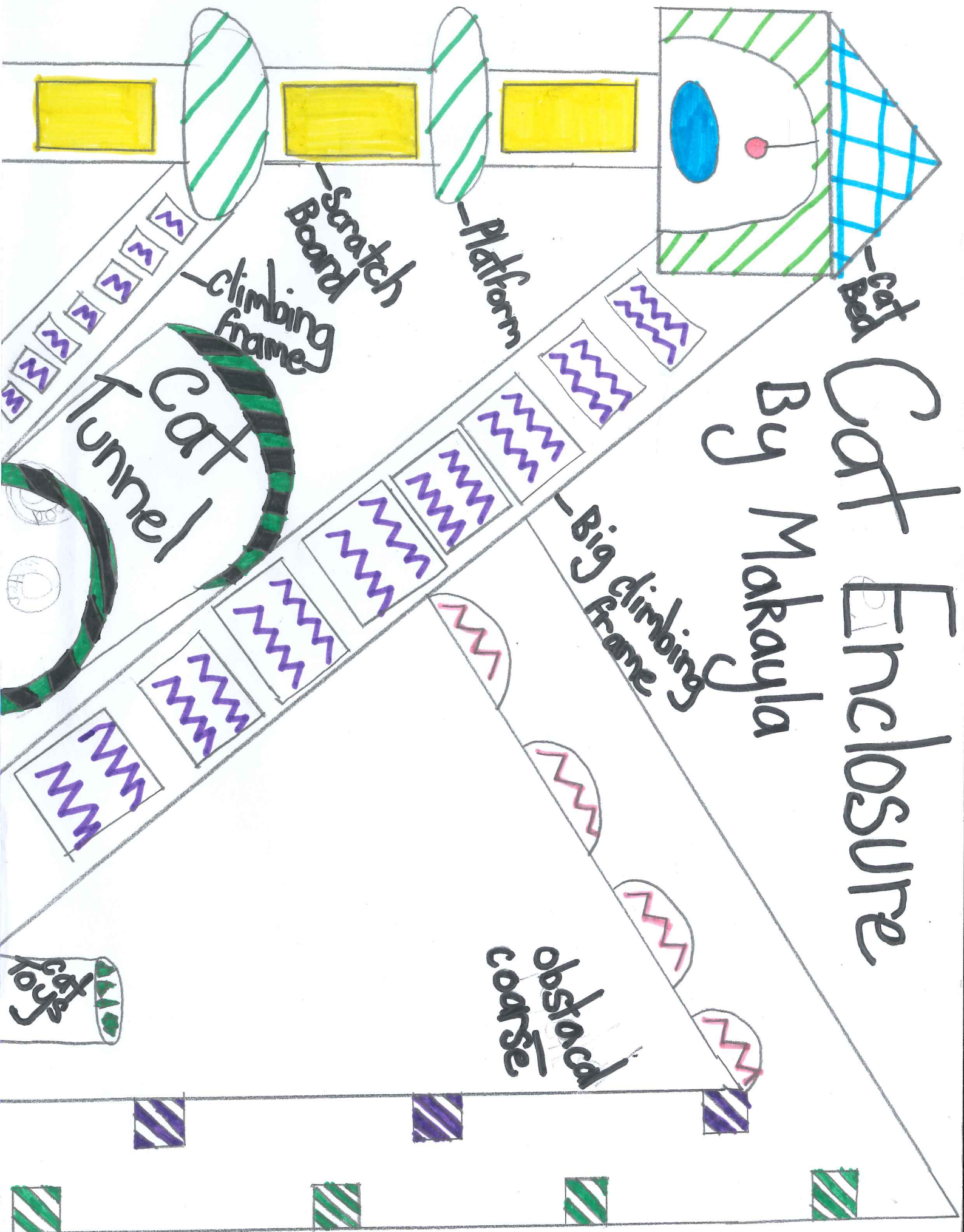

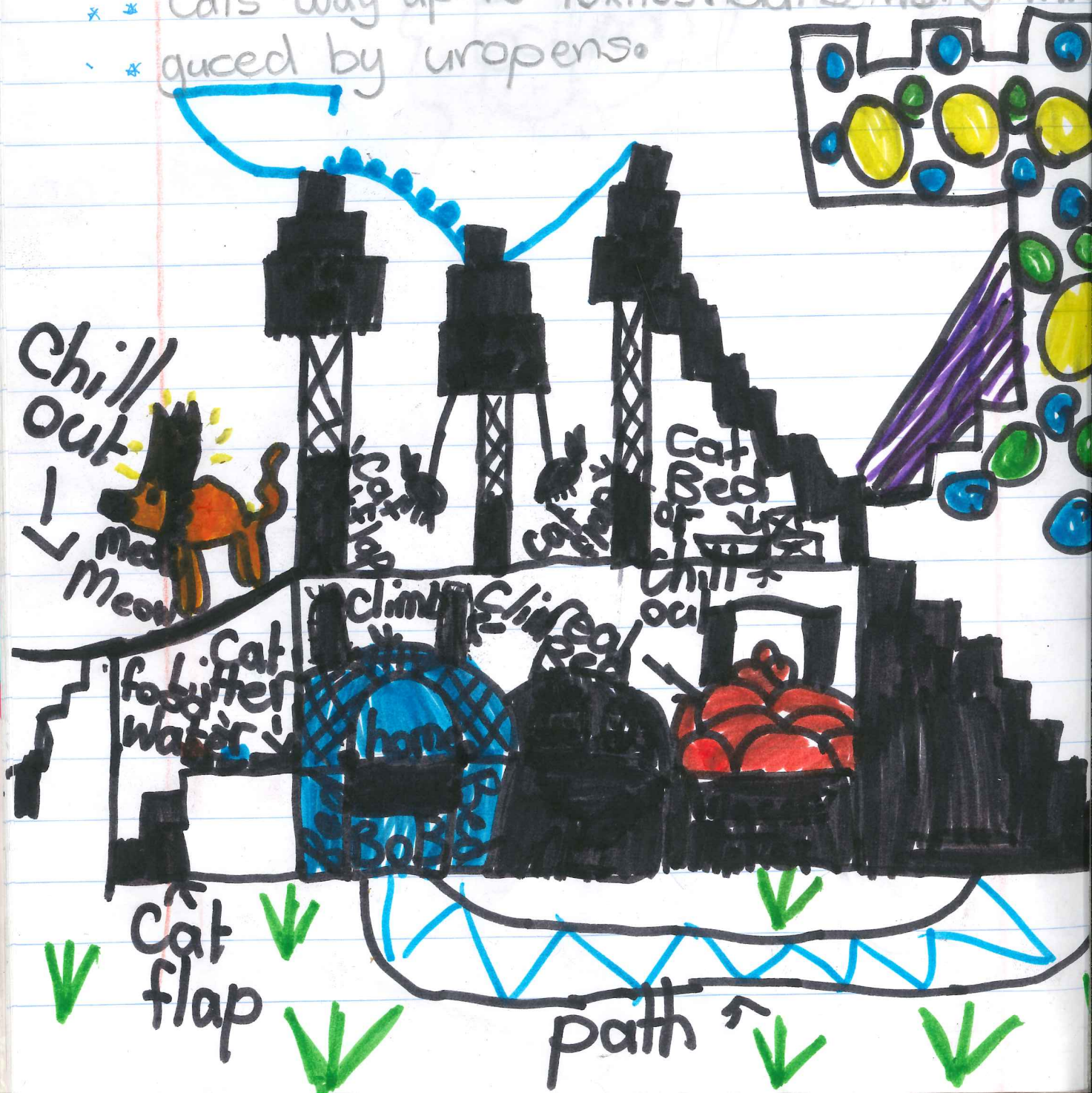

Cats have pads on their feet so that they can sneak up on their prey. In their pads they have tiny holes. In those holes they have hairs. Cats carry a very bad disease called Toxoplasmosis.
