Family Planning Tasmania will be visiting your child's class from Monday 3rd July – Thursday 6th July to provide *The Growing Up Program – a relationships, sexuality and protective behaviours program.* The program will run in Years Prep to 6.

Growing Up aims to provide your child with knowledge, skills and attitudes to help him/her make choices for positive emotional, physical and social health.

The program is age-appropriate and topics covered may include:

- Our bodies and how they work including private body parts
- How my body has grown and changed birth to present
- Rules about touch
- Conception, pregnancy and birth
- Feelings and emotions
- Healthy and safe relationships face to face and online
- Decision making and communication skills
- Puberty changes
- Valuing diversity

You are invited to attend a parent information session to find out more about *Growing Up* so that you can feel confident about discussing the program with your child. The session will also include tips, strategies and resources for talking about relationships and sexuality.
