- develop health plans which include strategies to maintain your wellbeing

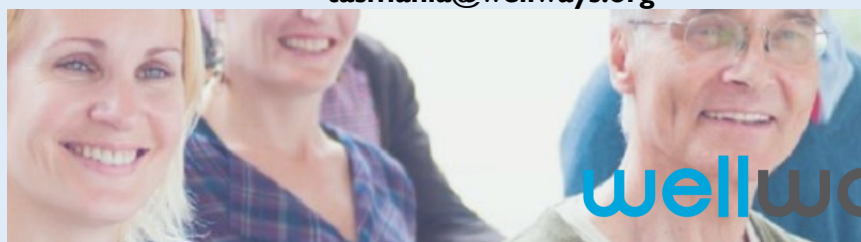
