SAFER SPEEDS FOR SCHOOLS - KINGBOROUGH

The Kingborough Council was recently successful in securing funding under the Tasmanian Government's Community Road Safety Grants Program for a Safe Speeds for Schools project. The project aims to improve road safety outcomes for students by influencing driver behaviour, targeting road users around schools at peak drop-off and pickup times when the speed limit is 40 km/hr.

Four portable digital radar speed display signs will soon be rotated around the municipality to target vehicles travelling through school zones.
