- \$55 a day per child (before CCS)
- Bookings are essential to secure a position and ensure educator to child ratios are maintained.
- Bookings cancelled after the closing date will be charged as 'Absent' or in line with legislative requirements.
- Each day our program is subject to change depending on the weather and children's interests.
- Morning and afternoon teas are provided and included with the cost.
- If your child/ren are sick a medical certificate will be required for fees to be waived.
- Your child/ren are able to bring along their bikes and/or scooters each day they are booked in for.
- Please: no crocs or thongs for safety reasons. Provide clothing that is appropriate for the weather/your child's needs.
- Hats are required for when the UV Rating is above 3. Please ensure your child/ren have a hat in their bag.

Angela's Equine Rescue and Respite

Equine Rescue and Respite care for horses that have had misfortune in their lives.



This image is one of their rescues which has had an amazing long journey. This one horse has had well into the thousands spent on it and made a great recovery. There is another three in their care currently.

Equine Rescue and Respite welcome volunteers for paddock cleaning and bagging of horse poo which is sold to raise money for these horses in need.

Some of the horses end up finding a lovely forever homes, while others become permanent residents.

In helping raise money for these horses in need, Equine Rescue and Respite have opened the farm to the public, where they offer "farm experience", feeding the animals, chickens, ducks, goats, and their pig called Betty. Children can also see and pet the rabbits and guinea pigs

They also offer "horse care" where they provide our own quiet horses and ponies for people to interact with, petting, grooming, and even pony rides.

SAFETY – Equine Rescue and Respite have a policy that all people under the age of 18 ARE TO WEAR A HORSE RIDING HELMET WHEN AROUND AND ON THE HORSES/PONIES AT ALL TIMES and solid/full covering shoes must be worn around the farm and near the horses/ ponies.
