**Saturday 26 March, 10am - 12:30pm**

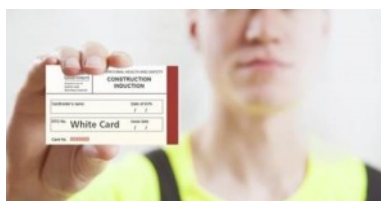
Be introduced to the tools and process of silk painting, and guided to create your own small piece. **Bookings required.**

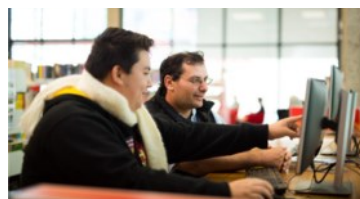
